6. Chairperson's Report:

- a. Pancake Tuesday
 - Anna's catering did a fabulous job. Tasted well. We were given several extra pancakes.
 - All ready on 1 pick up time (had previously arranged for 10 & 11)

- If we give a list of allergies, she may be able to accommodate prior. She can give a more in detail list of ingredients as requested by some parents
- Cost \$1200. we had supplies purchased from year prior: plates, cutlery, napkins
- Issues this year: setting up the tables in time for the next group with plates, Knife and then pancakes to be served
- Classrooms started coming down at 10:30. Started with SK first, higher grades last to eat the leftovers
- Need approximate calories for diabetics to assist the nurses with insulin if possible
- We were required to make gluten milk, vegan, egg substitute, butter milk, dairy free.
- Anna is able to make gluten free for next year (that would help us making them)
- We want to ask Father if we can have the church ladies make pancakes in 2024
- Council agreed that we were satisfied and would use Anna in the future if not allowed to return to the church
- b. Chocolate Fundraiser Update
 - 1. Profit this year with donations was \$2,684.21
 - Post covid, increase food cost are a few possibilities
 - Required to prepay \$90/box
 - Congratulations to top seller Isabelle M., runner-up Cyara O., and grand prize winner Silas B.
 - 2. Considering changing fund raiser next year. Try something different:
 - Possibly try several small fundraisers instead of the large chocolate option:
 - 1. Cookie dough
 - 2. Card box: send a child home with a box of cards and then are required to purchase. Pre-purchase a set # of boxes
 - 3. Krispy Kreme donuts.
 - 1. Our cost is \$7/dozen providing we purchase more then 50 dozen
 - 2. Other places have sold:
 - 1. 1 dozen \$12 (profit \$5).
 - 2. 2 dozen \$20 (profit \$6).
 - 3. Jess will find more info and will book 2 dates for next school year. Considering this to run fall and spring.
- c. Popcorn: Sales have slowed. In May will switch over to ice cream.
